DELHI CHILDLINE completes 11 years 10 months services in the best interest of children



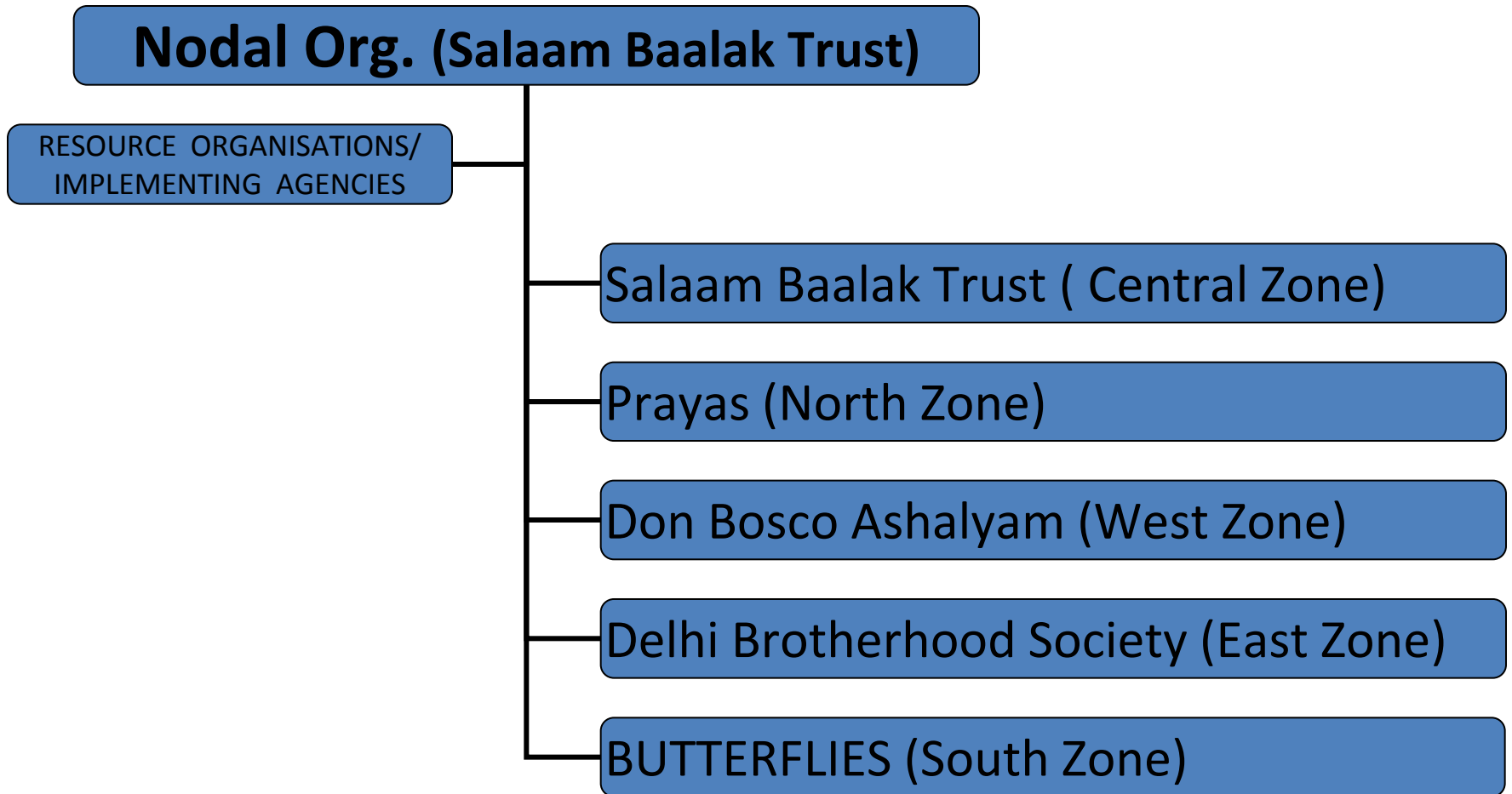
What is CHILDLINE?

CHILDLINE is a 24-hour toll free national telephonic emergency helpline service which operates to help the children in need of care and protection and children in distress.

Till date CHILDLINE is operational in 84 cities across India.

DELHI CHILDLINE NODAL... Introduction

Salaam Baalak Trust is currently the nodal agency of CHILDLINE Delhi. Mr. Varun Pathak, Salaam Baalak Trust is the Delhi City Coordinator.

The primary role of the nodal organization is to ensure effective networking and training of implementing organizations and their staff members.

The nodal organization ensures the effective functioning of the service by addressing challenges/issues that may emerge time to time

The Nodal organization has a City Coordinator who coordinates CHILDLINE activities on behalf of the nodal agency .

NODAL Delhi CHILDLINE ACTIVITIES

- Facilitates efficient and effective operation of the 5 zones of DELHI CHILDLINE.
- Acts as link between the 5 collaboration of Delhi CHILDLINE zones.
- Act as link between the CHILDLINE Collabs . and CHILDLINE INDIA FOUNDATION.
- Liaisoning and advocacy with government departments, allied systems and NGO's for efficient operation of all 5 Delhi CHILDLINES.
- Organize events and training workshops in support/ on behalf of Delhi CHILDLINE.
- Facilitate rescues and protection from abuse of children especially cases of Child (Bonded) Labour and Human Trafficking.
- Liasoning with task Force for Pre rescue Planning and Post rescue Rehabilitations.
- facilitating sensitization workshop for police especially Juvenile welfare officers.

Activities carried as Nodal Agency

- Coordinated task force and persuaded active role of CHILDLINE in the task force operations and in rescues of victims of child labour on priority basis.
- Facilitated CHILDLINE's in releasing certificates for 12 children registered as released from bonded (child) labour.
- Organized police sensitization program in central district by request of the Jt. Commissioner of police.
- Liasoned for support in legal cases by HRLN.

Activities carried as Nodal Agency

- ❑ Represented Delhi CHILDLINE view and concerns in Delhi Police Act, 1978, amendment, organized by B.P.R.D. Ministry of Home Affairs.
- ❑ Supported CHILDLINE central zone in rescuing 3 girls being trafficked from Jalpaigudi, West Bengal, F.I.R. lodged with trafficker arrested on spot and case being followed up by Crime branch.
- ❑ Planned and led the Mumbai (CCC) CHILDLINE contact centre interface with Delhi CHILDLINE coordinators, represented Delhi CHILDLINE and raised concerns and issues of the Delhi CHILDLINE.
- ❑ Planned and led the mass awareness on World Child Labour Eradication day (12 June) with Awareness Rally supported by SDM's, DLC and ACP Karol Bagh and Salaam Baalak Trust and other Childline agencies with NGO's and RAW
