Anil Kumar Tiwari – Social Worker, Uday Open Shelter



Anil Kumar Tiwari has facilitated the creation of **56 Aadhaar cards, 18 Sukanya Samriddhi accounts, and 25 ABHA health cards**. His resourcefulness was further evident in arranging a **community space free of cost**, reflecting his strong commitment to organizational activities and community support.

Mohammad Mujeeb – Welfare Officer, Apna Ghar



Mohammad Mujeeb has worked with an impressive **782 beneficiaries this year**, setting a milestone by independently restoring **441 children** through effective liaisoning. He also conducted **30 Home Visit cum Restorations** and **160 Restoration follow-ups**, highlighting his dedication to child protection and rehabilitation.

Asha – Social Worker, Child Help Desk, ODRS



Asha achieved the **highest outreach this year**, successfully intervening in **219 cases**. She traced families of over **40 children** in coordination with police stations and managed **five highly vulnerable cases**, resulting in the registration of **three FIRs** (2 under POCSO and 1 Missing case). Her efforts underscore her unwavering commitment to safeguarding children's rights.

Bharti Devi – Social Worker, Child Well Being Centre, Raghubir Nagar





RESUE

SUCCESSFUL RESCUE OPERATIONAL IN CONNAUGHT PLACE



A coordinated rescue effort in **Connaught Place** ensured the safe recovery of **16 children** (10 girls and 6 boys). This achievement was made possible through the collaboration of **Connaught Place Police Station** and NGO partners **CELR Foundation** and **Bal Vikas Dhara**.

Following the rescue, the children were placed in appropriate care institutions:

- **DMRC Udaan Home:** 10 girls
- **Bal Sahyog Home:** 6 boys

This operation highlights the **power of inter-agency collaboration** and the crucial role of coordinated civic and NGO engagement in protecting vulnerable children.

COLLABORATIVE RESCUE ENSURE SAFETY OF CHILDREN



On **27th August 2025**, a coordinated rescue operation in **Connaught Place** led to the safe recovery of **27 children** (11 girls, 16 boys). The initiative was made possible through the collaboration of **District Magistrate Mr. Sunny Kumar Singh**, **Sub-Divisional Magistrate Mr. O.P. Pandey**, the **District Child Protection Unit, Connaught Place** and **Mandir Marg Police Stations**, and NGO partners **CELR Foundation** and **Bal Vikas Dhara**.

Staff from **SBT Kishalaya**—Mr. Wasif, Ms. Neetu, Ms. Kanchan, and Ms. Asmeen—played a vital role on the ground. Following the rescue, the children were placed in suitable care institutions:

- **Bal Sahyog:** 15 children
- **SPYM De-addiction Centre:** 3 children
- **Udaan Home:** 8 children
- **Dwarka Home:** 1 child

CAMPS

Dental Camp



A **dental camp** was organized, where **102 children** received dental check-ups. Several children also received **on-the-spot treatment**, ensuring their oral health needs were promptly addressed.

T.B Screening



A **DOT screening and TB test camp** was organized, with **79 children registered** for the camp. **57 children** underwent **chest X-rays**, and **4 children** were found with potential chest infections. Further **sputum tests and Mantoux tests** will be conducted the following day to confirm the diagnosis and ensure timely treatment.

SUPPORT FOR FLOOD-AFFECTIVE FAMILIES



In partnership with **BUDS NGO**, medicines were distributed to children and their families affected by the floods, providing essential support during this challenging time.
